- Needs Assessment
 - STAR Reading and STAR Math will be administered three times in 2022-23; BOY September 2022; MOY December 2022; EOY May 2023
 - Additional screening & diagnostic reading assessments will begin September, 2022 Grades K-12; including but not limited to ORF, PAST, Beginning & Advanced Decoding Surveys
 - June 2022 Grades 9-12 Summer School to focus on Learning Loss in Literacy & Math
 - June 30 & July 1, 2022 Literacy PLC
 - Math PLCs will place focus on implementing an effective RTI Tier II & III process; the next scheduled PLC is July 20-22, 2022.
 - 2022-23 SY Lamar High School 9-12 will continue to implement Barton Dyslexia & Reading Intervention, a DESE approved Dyslexia & Reading program ADE approved Dyslexia program that is evidence-based
 - Reading Interventionist provides Tier II & III interventions to students scoring below 24 PR on STAR Reading & Below Benchmark on the Beginning & Advanced Decoding Surveys & fails three or more automaticity levels on the PAST
 - Math teachers provide RTI Tier II & III interventions to students scoring below 24 PR on STAR Math and/or students who are at risk of failing a math course
 - Sonday System; David Kilpatrick's Equipped for Reading Success & Heggerty Phonemic Awareness are used by trained Reading Interventionists to serve identified students

- Reading Interventionist & Special Education Teachers use Sonday System I & I; Equipped for Reading Success & Heggerty Interventions for Tier II/III. Barton will now be available to the Reading Interventionist.
- Literacy Teachers use “Turn it In” to detect grammar, mechanics issues & monitor plagiarism
- Beginning August 2022 Students showing deficiencies/at risk of failure are referred to the After School Tutoring program offered two days per week for the 2022-23 SY
- Guy Fenter Education Service Cooperative will provide Sonday System I & II training, ongoing for new hires
- 2022-23 SY Lamar School District will Implement the following for ESL students
 - Champion of IDEAS teacher and student sets - curriculum for English Language Development for an emerging or level 1 ESL student
 - Frames for Fluency Set 1 & 2 (bundled with Champion) - use the target frames to communicate and develop oral skills
 - Leveled readers - build literacy using on-level books
