

End-of-Year On-Campus Activities and Continuity of Instruction Plan

Hackett School District is maintaining almost all of the mitigation measures as described in our existing plan we have used since the school year began. The following are specific items important for continuing safe in-person instruction to include activities and events at the end of the school year.

- Wear masks on school buses in accordance with CDC mandate
- Encourage masks by all individuals at school when social distancing of at least 3 feet is not possible. (recommended distance is now 3 feet)
 - The Superintendent will have the ability to enforce a mandate on an emergency basis up to two weeks or until a board meeting can be held to review a policy change in the event of a local outbreak where immediate steps are needed and a state mandate is not in effect.
- Maintain and/or use social distancing when possible
- We are continuing to provide hand sanitizer at all building entrances and in classrooms
- Ventilation systems are being treated with ionization measures that are proven to kill viruses and bacteria
- Visitors to school are still restricted to most safe practices
- We continue to use CDC/Department of Health close contact guidance for determining quarantine requirements
- All scheduled activities and events will occur in accordance with mandates as required with encouragement of participants and/or attendees to practice recommended guidance such as masks, social distancing, and etc.
