

Student Nutrition Information

Welcome to our new school year. This informational letter will help explain the items you need to know as a parent.

The menus and program information can be found on our website under the Cafeteria tab.

If you have not already filled out a lunch application for this school year, please contact your students' secretary and get a copy to fill out and return quickly. If at any time, your financial situation or family size changes please fill out another application to see if you can qualify for free or reduced.

The prices for meals this year are as follows:

Breakfast at all campuses is \$1.25.

Lunch (PK-5th) is \$2.30.

Lunch (6-12th) is \$2.40.

Reduced Prices are .30 for breakfast and .40 for lunch for all ages.

Honey Grove ISD policy is to allow no more than \$5.00 to be past due for any student.

If a student owes more than \$5.00 they will be served an alternate lunch until the account is brought back to a .00 balance. And we cannot offer them breakfast until the account is brought back to a .00 balance. Alternate lunch consists of a cheese sandwich, fresh fruit and choice of milk.

Please monitor your child's balance by signing up with www.myschoolBucks.com which can be accessed under **Cafeteria** tab on the Honey Grove ISD website www.honeygroveisd.net.

You will need your student's ID number to enroll, which you will find on their schedule, or you may ask your campus secretary. Be sure and go to e-mail preferences and select "Send email when one or more account balances fall below \$_____" (you fill in the amount). You may pay online and the convenience fee is \$2.49 per transaction (you can pay for more than one student per transaction). They accept Visa, Mastercard, Discover and Electronic Check.

You may continue to send your payment to any office. Payments by check or money order are more convenient for allowing us to apply the funds to the correct account.
