Administrative Guidelines: High School Attendance Incentive Program

ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAM: WHEREAS, United Independent School District (“UISD”) believes in investing in student achievement and feels regular school attendance is essential for the student to make the most of his or her education.

THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees has approved local funds to be used to establish a high school attendance incentive program.

PURPOSE: These guidelines are to be adhered to ensure consistency with UISD policies and procedures when dealing with the High School Attendance Incentive Program (the “program”).

DEFINED: The program is designed to encourage high school students to attend school on a daily basis and attain an exceptional attendance record which the District feels will lead to improved student performance and will instill responsibility and self-esteem in students at UISD. The program will provide incentives for those eligible students who have attained a perfect attendance record for a determined attendance campaign period.

ELIGIBILITY: High School Students who are enrolled in any of the four UISD high schools in grades 9-12 are eligible to participate in this program. **Students must have been enrolled for at least two classes in their respective high school by Monday of the 2nd week of the nine week period to be considered eligible for the program for the respective nine week period.**

PERFECT ATTENDANCE: Perfect attendance is considered an exceptional attendance record with a student having been in each scheduled class on a daily basis. As per the UISD Student Handbook, under the Attendance section, “students must be in class when the bell rings at the beginning of each class period. Students are to be marked tardy if they report to class after the bell rings without a proper excuse. Four tardies or early releases in any one class shall be counted as one unexcused absence for award and perfect attendance purposes.” The only absences considered “excused” for this program will be **those absences recognized as “excused” per the Texas Education Code Section 25.087.**

ATTENDANCE CAMPAIGN PERIOD(S): The attendance campaign period (s) will run from the first day of the school year through the last day of the school year as published in the annual school calendar adopted by the Board of Trustees. The adopted school calendar defines the dates to be included in a “nine week” period and a “semester” period.

VERIFICATION OF PERFECT ATTENDANCE: The UISD student attendance system, known as Tyler Technologies (“Tyler), is the official attendance record system for the district. The campus principal, or designee, will utilize Tyler to verify for each defined attendance campaign period which students have attained perfect attendance for this program.

STUDENT INCENTIVES: Incentives should be appropriate for students of high school age, be of a reasonable value, and also be conducive to entice school wide participation from all eligible students.

DISTRIBUTION OF INCENTIVE(S): The District should develop an annual written plan to define the attendance campaign period (s); which incentives will be awarded per campaign period, when the award will take place, etc. The plan should also address how the program will be marketed and communicated to students and parents.

Student incentives will be awarded in a consistent manner among all four high schools. A drawing that allows for equal opportunity of chance will take place in a public setting with student and staff representatives present. Winners should be announced immediately.

SELECTION OF WINNER(S): All decisions by UISD faculty and administration regarding the issuance of incentives or opportunities to participate in drawings for incentives are final and may not be appealed.

BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS: Due to the District’s commitment to the program, the Board of Trustees will allocate each budgetary year from local funds for the program. The amount allocated will be determined to be no less than a 1/8th percentage of average daily attendance (ADA) rate earned by a high school based on their projected enrollment for the coming school year through the Texas Education Agency’s (TEA) attendance calculation.
