Distance Learning Participation

This school year at Stringtown Schools will be much different for students than years before. As you know by now, we will have distance learning Fridays in which students will not attend here at school, but they will be required to attend school virtually, through distance learning. We will deliver instruction through Google Classroom and we need your support to ensure the success of our efforts. Our goal is to educate our students in this non-traditional manner in case our school is shut down again due the coronavirus pandemic. Please take a moment to review our plan below and talk with your child about the importance of continuing their education during these distance learning days.

What you can expect from our teachers:

Students will receive core (ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies) instruction through Google Classroom.

Students should login each Friday to check for assignments and instructions from the teacher.

Teachers will be available to monitor and assist students from 9:00 to 3:00 regarding questions about assignments and instructional material.

What you can expect from your students:

Students should login to each of their Google Classrooms each Friday.

Students will need to complete all required assignment and submit these as directed by their teacher.

Students are required to complete all coursework on distance learning Fridays, or they will not receive any credit for those assignments. The coursework on these days will count towards report cards and their eligibility with extracurricular activities.

Students should email teachers if they have any questions.
