3. Academic Goal (Math): To increase the percentage of Special Education students meeting state standards from 68% to 83%
4. Academic Goal (Science): To increase the percentage of Special Education students meeting state standards from 52% to 68%.
5. Academic Goal (Social Studies): To increase the percentage of the Special Education students meeting state standards from 43% to 60%.

1. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress through progress reports and Parent Portal.
2. Develop academic assignments to complete at home with parental portal.
3. Develop interactive materials (online and in print) to use at home in order to reinforce and review concepts learned in the classroom.
4. Hold parent-teacher conferences during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.
5. Provide parents with opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class to observe classroom activities.
6. Ensure that my child will read for 30 minutes each day at home.
