District Goals

- Academic Goal (Reading): To increase the percentage of Special Education students meeting state standards from 31.6% to 50.8%
2. Academic Goal (Writing): To increase the percentage of Special Education students meeting state standards from 24.7% to 47.4%
 3. Academic Goal (Math): To increase the percentage of Special Education students meeting state standards from 44.3% to 57.2%
 4. Academic Goal (Science): To increase the percentage of Special Education students meeting state standards from 41% to 53%
 5. Academic Goal (Social Studies): To increase the percentage of Special Education students meeting the state standards from 26% to 45.5%

Campus Goals

1. Academic Goal (Reading): To increase the percentage of all students meeting state standards from 56% to 61%.
2. Academic Goal (Math): To increase the percentage of all students meeting state standards from 91% to 95%.
3. Academic Goal (Science): To increase the percentage of all students meeting state standards from 82% to 91%.
4. Academic Goal(Social Studies): To increase the percentage of all students meeting state standards from 89% to 94%.

Strategies for parents to help campus achieve its goals:

- Parent strategy to achieve Reading goal: To encourage at least 30 minutes of reading at home.
2. Parent strategy to achieve Math goal: To communicate via phone/e-mail with their child's teacher regarding grades and attendance.
 3. Parent strategy to achieve Science goal: To promote research of science-based websites.
 4. Parent strategy to achieve Social Studies goal: To discuss with your children the topics you learn about while reading the newspaper, surfing the web, or watching the news.
