



Brief History of the Texas Girls Coaches Association

The Texas Girls Coaches Association is one of the largest associations of coaches, and the largest association for coaches of girls' athletics in the United States. Established in 1953 with a membership of less than 100, it has grown to in excess of 7,000 members today and includes coaches and administrators in all levels of education.

The governing body -- officers, directors, committee chairs - are coach members selected by TGCA administration members. The TGCA is sanctioned by the Texas University Interscholastic League although it is not a part of the UIL. TGCA honors athletes and coaches in all sports sanctioned by the UIL.

It is with great pleasure that the Texas Girls Coaches Association recognizes our 4 athletes with their achievement certificates. These athletes have accomplished very special honors, which the association recognizes each school year for our member coaches.
