All medications must be brought to the school by the parent, guardian, or responsible adult. DO NOT send medication to school with your child.

It is the time of year where students are prescribed medication due to illness. If a student is prescribed a medication to be given three times per day, it can be administered before school, after school, and before bed to eliminate school involvement with administration.
