\$65 per credit hour (HS tuition rate) \$13 per credit hour book fee (not all courses will require this)

<u>Excel in CTE (SB155)</u> – Students do not pay the tuition rate for CTE courses that fall under this category. These courses are free of cost unless there are consumable fees associated with the course. These fees will vary depending on the program.

<u>Payment plans</u> – All students are required to pay for their courses in full or set up a payment plan. Students will not be able to enroll each semester if they have a previous balance. Transcripts are also held until all balances are paid. There is a payment plan fee of \$15 when they are set up directly through out business office (the fee is higher is plan is set up online).

Enrollment Process

- 1. Complete the survey Mr. Murrison sent via email.
- 2. Have four core class and one administrator approve you taking college level classes
- 3. Take placement test (if required)
- 4. Apply online at indycc.edu, make sure you choose "ICC NOW"
- 5. Receive ICC ID and account information





Drop/Withdrawal Process

STUDENTS MUST HAVE PERMISSION FROM AN ADMINISTRATOR TO DROP OR WITHDRAW FROM A CLASS!

Drop:

If a student decides to drop a class they can do so within the first week of classes. If a student drops they will not be charged for the course (consumables that have been opened or used cannot be refunded) and the class will not show on their ICC transcript.

Withdraw:

If a student withdraws from a course they are still responsible for paying for the course and all charges and the student will receive a W on their ICC transcript. This does not effect the students ICC GPA.
