### **How long have you shown chickens?**

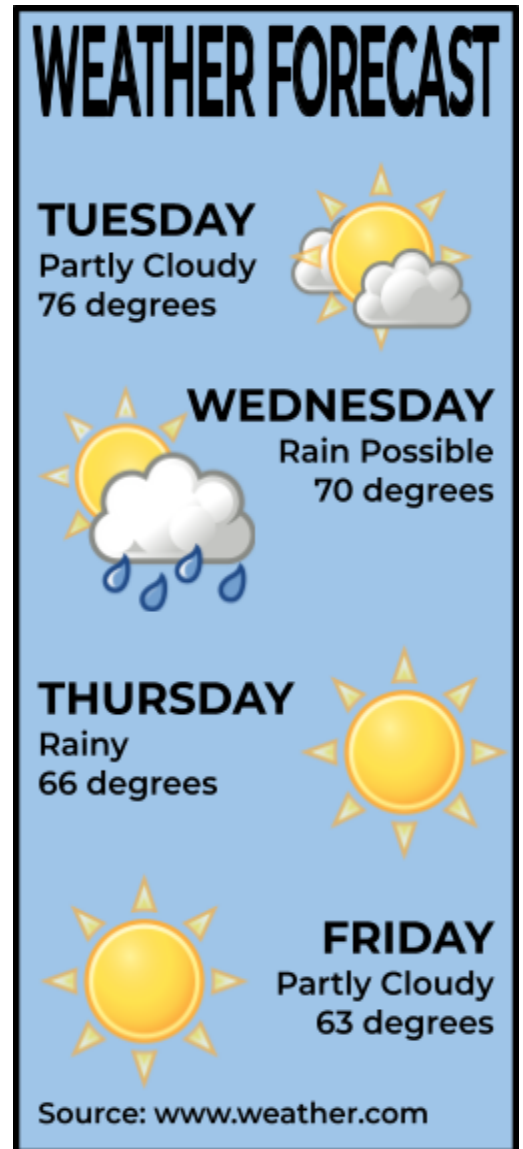
“Since the 7th Grade.”

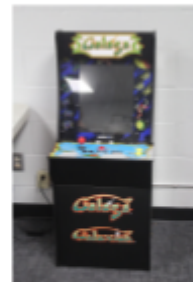
