OES's dates for taking this years Missouri Assessment (MAP) test for grades 3, 4 and 5, is May 2nd through the 14th with make-up dates being May 15th through 17th.

A few days before testing starts we have a fun MAP carnival celebration planned just for our students to help them relax, have fun, and get out some of those pre-test day jitters and anxieties.

Attendance is key for testing! Family members can help us keep our kiddos on track by making sure they are in attendance AND on time on test days.

With our window being at the end of the school year, and with field trips and picnics and party days (all the fun stuff), there is very little time left for make-up test dates.

The MAP test assesses student's pro-

gress toward the educational standards in Missouri. It is a way to see if the students are learning what they need to be based on their grade level. It also plays an important role in educational funding for our school. Educators use the test results to improve teaching and learning based on Missouri learning standards. Policymakers use the results to make decisions for each school, each school district, and for the state. The MAP results are vital to funding, innovation, and higher learning standards...

Our students have been working all year preparing themselves for the test — they are ready. We can all help them by making sure they arrive on time. Once testing has begun, we cannot interrupt until the class in between sessions. If a student is late, they may have to wait until a session is over before heading to class then make up that missed session later. Same for students who have to

leave early. We cannot call a class for a student during a session. If they are needed, then we would have to wait to call them down when there is a break.

We can also help our testers, by making sure they get a good nights sleep and a good breakfast. If they don't have time to eat at home, be sure they stop to have breakfast at school on test days.

And most of all, we can help by keeping them positive and encouraging them — they know the work, they got this!

3rd gr. — 5/3, 5/6, 5/9, 5/10 (9am to approx. 10:30am)

4th gr.— 5/6, 5/7, 5/8, 5/10, 5/13 (9am to approx. 10:45am)

5th gr. — 5/2, 5/3, 5/8, 5/9, 5/13, 5/14 (9:45am to approx. 11:30am)
