# GEARING UP FOR A NEW YEAR

Although we have almost an entire month of school left, there are still some things to keep in mind as this year comes to a close and we gear up for the 2019-2020 school year.

— Students and parents can find out who next year's teachers are around July 1st. Class lists will again be posted on the front doors of the building. Custodians and maintenance will be working so the gates will be open during the day.

—The first day of school for the 2019-2020 school year is on Wednesday, August 14th.

—School supply lists will be available by the last day of school. We will also have them posted on the front doors, on our Facebook page, and available at local retail outlets.

—You can always stay up-to-date with school info through our Facebook page (Owensville Elementary), through the district webpage, through News and Events on the GCR2 app, and in the local newspaper. Also, be sure to look for the Back to School Supplement in the local Gasconade Count Republican newspaper in August. It will have a lot of important info regarding the upcoming school year, staff, important dates, supply lists, etc...

—OES Open House will be Aug. 8th from 5 to 7pm.

Please make every effort to make it to open house. There is lots of information to receive and verify before the first day of school. Come prepared to fill out paperwork. It's extremely important that we receive back the first of the year paperwork no later than a week after school starts. The following are items that will need to be done on open house night:

1. Confirm transportation with the Transportation department. It's also a good idea that you let the teacher know what the student will be doing on the first day. \*Please note, pick up and drop off for students is in the <a href="back">back</a> of the building. Pick ups in the office at the end of the day are for emergencies or appointments <a href="mailto:only">only</a>.\*

2. The orange folders handed out are our student handbook, so they are yours to keep— and read. (school calendar dates are on the back)

3. You may deposit money in your child's lunch accounts. Free and reduced lunch forms have to be renewed every year. We advise everyone to fill it out. All info is confidential and if you qualify it's one less payment to worry about — think of it as the best coupon ever!

4. Students may also bring in their supplies so they don't have to carry them on the first day.

## Summer School

If students have not turned in Summer School forms yet, we will still accept them, however, we cannot guarantee exact transportation stops. Notes will go home on the last day of school providing teacher and transportation information. The first day will be on Tuesday, May 28th and the last day is Friday, June 7th. School is from 8:30-3:30pm and parent pick up and drop off is in the back of the building like the typical school days. Again, we highly recommend our incoming kindergarteners to come to summer school so they can get familiar with the "big school" and their new surroundings at a time when there are fewer students in the building.
