

Attendance in school is very important. However, we know there are illnesses and events that can prevent a student from being in attendance. We do ask that if your child will not be in attendance, you call the office by 10am. If you call before 7:30am, you can leave a message on the attendance line. If we have not received a call by 10am, we will start calling to verify the absence. This is a

procedure that all schools in the GCR2 district follow.

We run an attendance report each week, and any student, whether the absence is verified or not, will get an email or letter after 3, 5, 8, and 12 absences. Letters are to let parents be aware of the amount of absences their child has and should only be a cause for concern if they have

numerous absences. If your child visits a doctor, please be sure to turn in a doctor's note so we can mark attendance accordingly. If we call to verify and are unable to leave a message or if no one calls back, the

absence is marked as unexcused.
