Paperwork

Please be sure you have returned all of the beginning of the year paperwork. We know how much you all love it, and may want to keep it, but we really need it back as soon as possible. Be sure you have fully filled out verification forms, transportation forms, and health forms with your most current info. Teachers also need technology forms returned before students are allowed to get on the chrome books to work on assignments and to take tests.

Parent Pick-Up/Drop-Off

Our first priority is to get buses on the road before we release parent pick up. The end of day in all buildings has been extended five minutes, so we now release our 1st round buses at 3:20pm

so the earliest parent pick-up will be released is approximately 3:30pm. Picking up student's in the office at the end of day is ONLY in the event of an emergency or if there is an appointment you have to make it to in time. Sorry, but this is not for daily pick-up just so you don't have to sit in the line. Please remember, everyone's time is valuable.

Drop-off in the morning is in the back until 8:30am. Any students arriving after 8:30 will need to be brought in to the front and signed in by the person dropping them off. Tardies begin at 8:31am. Also, all students who leave school before 3:20pm will have to be signed out in the office.

Absences

Attendance counts — literally. We are aware there are instances when kiddos are sick and should not be in school (some things are not meant for sharing;-) In the event that your child will be absent, whether sick, at an appointment, or out of town, please be sure you call the office before 10am. After 10am we have to call all absent students to verify the absence. If you call before 7:30am, you can select the attendance line option and leave us a message. You can find more detailed information regarding attendance in the white packet of papers that were handed out at open house.
