The Support Team for At-Risk Students is a team of professionals available to support the needs of classroom teachers in an effort to care for their neediest students. The goal of this team is to be a Tier III level of intervention and support to teachers by conducting observations, problem-solving with the teacher, developing strategies and interventions through collaboration, prioritizing the needs of the student, and developing next steps for the teacher and student. The concentration is for students with autism, severe classroom behaviors & mental health related behaviors, with the requirement that the student has an IEP.
