



Dear Parents,

The Bay School District applied for Alternative Methods of Instruction (AMI) for inclement weather days. We received five days from the state to use as AMI days. The first five days we are out for inclement weather will be used as AMI days. Any days after the first five will be made up. AMI days will be announced on social media.

On an AMI day, the students will be able to do work at home, so the day will not have to be made up. Students in grades K-6 will receive a packet of work each nine weeks to work on during the AMI days. They will pull work that matches the skills in which they are working on that week. The skills for the week can be found on their weekly newsletter. Students in grades 7-12 will do work on their laptops through Google Classroom. They will receive their assignments in the Google Classroom.

Students in grades K-6 will bring their work to school. Students will have two days after the AMI day to turn in their work and be counted present for the day. Students in grades 7-12 will turn their work in through Google Classroom.

Teachers will be available by email or on Google Classroom from 8:00 am-3:00 pm on the AMI days.
