Parents or legal guardians should have the following documents in hand when they come to pre-register a child:

- the child's official birth certificate;
- the child's social security card;
- custody papers, if applicable;
- proof of residency;
- proof of income; and
- parent or guardian drivers license

All required documents must be submitted to the Givens registrar to complete enrollment.

Teacher requests must be made in person. They are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis and will be limited to fourteen per teacher. All required documents must be submitted before requesting a teacher. Parent choices are not binding—the director will finalize class placement. Summer office hours will be 8:30a.m.–3:300 p.m., Monday through Thursday. If necessary, parents may contact the registrar to arrange an appointment at a different time.
