

Eustace High School Exemption Policy

Students at Eustace High School will be rewarded for good attendance and good conduct with up to three exemptions per semester. Absences will be counted on an 18 week (semester) basis. The requirements are as follows:

1. Number of exemptions will be determined by the number of absences each semester.

0 absences w/ 75 or Above Average = 3 exemptions

1 - 2 absences w/ 80 or Above Average = 2 exemptions

3 absences w/ 85 or Above Average = 1 exemption

2. State policy will be followed in determining an absence.
3. Students with more than three absences are ineligible.
4. Any unexcused absence will make student ineligible.
5. Freshmen and sophomores cannot exempt more than 2 of the following courses: English, Math, Science, Social Studies. Violation of this policy will result in loss of 3rd exemption.
6. Students must have been enrolled at EHS at least 90% of the semester.
7. An alternative placement any time during a semester will automatically disqualify a student.
8. We will provide an opportunity for students to take a semester exam, even though they qualify for an exemption. The student's course grade will not be lowered by the exam grade if the student chooses to take an exam for which he/she qualifies for an exemption.
9. The semester average will be used to determine exemption grades.
10. Students that attend school for part of a day and leave for a documented medical or dental appointment will not be counted absent and will not lose an exemption.
11. Students must be present on the day of exams for ADA purposes. Students who are absent on exam day could lose the opportunity for exemptions the next semester.
