- \$7000 for Play Works
 - 1 week training
 - o Transitions and management
 - Conflict Resolution
 - Cooperative and inclusive play
 - Structured games for recess
- \$7309 for Math Manipulatives (basic all grade levels)
- \$7300 for Science Manipulatives
 - Science kits
 - Lakeshore Kits
- Contingency IF there are more funds
 - Waterford Early Reading Program

Review Current Year's Spending:

- \$20,000 in books library books and leveled readers for intervention instruction
- \$7,000 in Math and Science materials have been purchased
- Interventionist have been hired and are working- started late in to the year
- Left over funds: due to plan being approved after the start of year, not full year's salary required for reading aides that were hired
- All materials requested and needed by teachers have been purchased with some leftover funds as well

Remaining funds total: \$18,000 - \$20,000

- Gina teachers would like more technology (next year 1st grade 4 classes, 3rd 6th 1 extra class each)
- With the increase in number of students, team decided to ammend the current plan and utilize the leftover funds to purchase 2 additional Chromebook carts at \$20,000.

Allotment for 2018 - 2019 school year \$21,228.00

Steps of Action Plan:

- Continue reading goal from previous year and partially fund reading aide for the full year for intensive intervention needs- \$6,228
- Purchase an additional iPad cart to maximize individualized instruction time with the additional of another first grade class in the coming school year- \$15,000

Ideas were presented for consideration:

Considerations were made for how to provide supports through after school tutoring as well as also providing supports during the school day for those students unable to stay for tutoring.

The Committee discussed difficulties with hiring highly qualified staff for teaching assistant positions and also the desire to have a certified teacher providing targeted intervention and tutoring for math and reading if at all possible.

In order to address student needs in the areas of math and reading as identified by school data and student academic scores, the following goals were adopted for the upcoming plan:

Reading - would like to get a highly qualified literacy specialist to help with students that are at benchmark or lower, providing interventions during the school day and offer tutoring to help those in need after school.

Math - would like to get a highly qualified mathematics specialist to provide intervention instruction to students and offer tutoring to help those in need.
