STAAR TESTING APRIL 20, 21 AND 22ND

Remind your child that the STAAR is not that different from any other test they take. If they are doing ok in class, they will probably do ok on STAAR. Sometimes just a reminder that they know the material on the test can calm their nerves.

Get plenty of sleep the night before the test. A tired child cannot focus on the test. The room is quiet and that makes them even sleepier.

Make sure they get some play time and some exercise around testing time. Their minds need a break after sitting and focusing on a test. This will also help them relax and sleep better at night.

Eat breakfast. Food fuels the brain and the body. Get to school early enough to eat breakfast in the cafeteria and relax with friends.

Support them with a little praise. Kids need to hear how much you love them and believe in them. Your child is more than a test score. They need to hear that from all of us, often .
