We are excited to announce that our School Check-in System will be going soon! This is being implemented district-wide, so if you have kids on other campuses, this will apply to those schools as well.

We'll be "practicing" this week, so if you stop in the office to sign in, we may ask you for your drivers' license instead of letting you use the sign-in book. We still have some areas in the printing badges process that "need a little work"

Here's how it will work:

The first time you check-in, we'll ask for your drivers' license or other state-issued ID. We'll scan it into the system, and print out a pass for you to wear. It will have your ID picture, name and date of visit. Please wear this in a visible location on your clothing while you are with us. When you are ready to leave, stop in the office again so we can check you out.

If you DON'T have an ID: We'll ask for some basic info - first name, last name, city/state/zip, and your date of birth. That info will also generate a name badge for you to wear while you're in the building. You'll also stop by the office on your way out so we can check you out.

Once you have checked-in once, all you'll need is to know your drivers' license number to be able to check-in and receive a badge!

This is totally new system and there will be some bumps in the road to implementation. We will appreciate your patience and understanding as we get used to this new system! This system will help us welcome visitors and identify any adult in our building.
