Flu season is definitely in full swing! The flu gets its name from the virus that causes it — the influenza virus. The flu is very contagious and spreads when people cough or sneeze out droplets that are infected with the virus and other people breathe them in. The droplets also can land on things like doorknobs or shopping carts, infecting people who touch these things. When people have the flu, they usually feel worse than they do with a cold. Most people start to feel sick about 2 days after they come in contact with the flu virus. Common signs and symptoms are fever, chills, muscle aches, sore throat, headache, cough and general fatigue. The flu can turn into a serious illness like pneumonia if not treated swiftly and properly. Children with the flu should stay home from school until they feel better. They should only go back when they have been fever-free for at least 24 hours without using a fever-reducing medicine. Some kids need to stay home longer. Fever and other flu symptoms often go away after 5 days or so, but some may still have a cough or feel weak for some time after that. Please keep your child at home if you suspect any fever or other signs and symptoms of the flu. Good hand hygiene, rest, hydration, and staying home to rest will certainly help everyone feel better soon!
