



ACT Information for VIRTUAL STUDENTS and Face to Face students (March 9, 2021)

Who is testing?

- Current Juniors (class of 2022) - face to face and virtual students
- Current seniors who have not already taken the ACT (class of 2021)- face to face and virtual
- Current seniors who are retesting- face to face and virtual

Did I need to register prior to taking the test?

- You do not need to register prior to taking the test
- All registration was automatically completed by the school

Do I need to pay to take the test?

- You do not need to pay to take the test since this not a national testing date
- The administration is being funded by the state's Department of Education

How do I receive transportation?

- Face to face students- come to school using your regular methods of transportation (driving, bus, drop off)
- Virtual students- if you need bus transportation, please check the link that was sent out through an automated text and provide the information requested

What time do I need to arrive on testing day?

- Students should arrive to school by 7:20.

How do I know if I am scheduled to test?

- Face to face students- Will receive a copy of their schedule with their location to report to
- Virtual students- login to the student progress center to view your schedule. If it says ACT on your schedule, then you are scheduled to test.
- Schedules will also be posted on the wall in the main hallways when you arrive

When can I expect to finish testing?

- Testing will end around 11:30/12:00... face to face students will remain on campus until the end of the school day
- Virtual students- may leave after testing... if you do not have transportation to leave, you will remain in the auditorium until the end of the school day at 2:45

What forms and items will I need to complete prior to coming on March 9th?

- Virtual students only: 2 forms about COVID- The district's COVID forms. These can both be found on the NISH website.
- ALL STUDENTS MUST BRING one of the following: A school ID, driver's license, or any government issued valid ID
- ALL STUDENTS- bring your chrome book (CHARGED)

What do I wear to school on March 9th?

- All students may wear school appropriate jeans and a spirit shirt to school.
