No charge for Summer School

Welcome to the 2022 Iberia Parish School Secondary Summer School. Since summer school instruction is delivered virtually, we use the Edgenuity online platform. Some of the face-to-face courses offered in our schools are not available virtually and cannot be taken during summer school. Your child's guidance counselor will help you to determine which courses are available and which are recommended for completion in summer school.

Orientation for all summer school classes will be held at NISH on Friday, June 3 at 9:00 am. All summer school students should plan to attend. At this time you will be given your login, as well as a tour of the program. Students who are familiar with the Edgenuity program should still attend since policies and procedures such as how to schedule your cumulative exam will also be discussed. Edgenuity classes will begin on Monday, June 6 and all coursework (including the cumulative exam) must be completed by Thursday, June 30 at 1:30 pm. (No exams will be scheduled to begin later than 11:30 pm on June 30.)

Important Reminders:

1. Students are encouraged to work without help from other sources as they complete their pre-test and lessons. Using outside help may help students do well on the pre-test and lessons, but the material will appear again on the cumulative exam, and if students cannot complete these lessons successfully on their own, they will not be successful on the cumulative exam where no help is allowed. Without successful completion of the cumulative exam, students will not receive credit.
2. Students who are struggling with the lessons should come into the lab to meet with a tutor who can help them learn the material. Tutoring will be available Monday – Friday from 8:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
3. After completion of the course, students must schedule and complete their cumulative exams before a grade can be awarded.
4. Testing can occur throughout the summer school session; do not wait until the final week (June 27 – June 30) to schedule your test. Testing slots during this week will be limited.
5. Students should complete their coursework by June 26 to allow themselves enough time to be scheduled for testing.

As in previous years, students must provide their own transportation, and all regulations governing the behavior of students and dress code during the regular school session will be in effect. If you have any questions, please contact Mr. Curt Landry at 369-6714.
