Honors Program Requirements

- To be recognized as an Honor graduate, students must have a total of 29 credits of which a minimum of 15 must be Honors/DE/AP/Gifted courses.
- Additionally, 10 of the 15 Honors/DE/AP/Gifted credits must be in the academic areas of English, Math, Social Studies or Science.

Valedictorian Requirements

- The valedictorian will be the Honor Program graduate with the highest weighted cumulative grade point average. The valedictorian will give the commencement address.
- The salutatorian will be the Honor Program graduate with the second highest weighted cumulative grade point average. The salutatorian will give the welcome address.
- In the event of a tie for valedictorian, co-valedictorians will be named and share the responsibility of the commencement address. Additionally, no salutatorian will be named and the welcome address will be given by the student with the next highest weighted cumulative grade point average.

Dual Enrollment



- Student receives both high school and college credit
- ACT score minimums: Math 19 English 18 Composite 19—Last opportunity to take ACT if you do not have the scores is June 13, 2020. You must register by May 8, 2020 in order to avoid late fees.
- GPA: 2.5
- Must adhere to university policies and do not have access to Iberia Parish's recovery programs
- There is a cost of tuition for each course—Iberia Parish will fund one Math or one English course for all enrolled students. Additional courses are the financial responsibility of students and their parents. Students will not be allowed to enroll in a course for which they have not paid, per the Dual Enrollment contract. The deadline will be announced when the contract is finalized. Tuition may be due prior to the start of the 20-21 school year.
