In accordance with the educational goals of the district, we have designed an individual program of academic instruction to address the special language needs of your child.

The English proficiency test scores indicate that your child has limited English proficiency and would benefit from one of the following specialized language instruction programs offered:

Specialized Programs

The specialized language program that you have selected for your child will enable him/her to become English proficient and access the general education curriculum to ensure academic success in school. If applicable, the expected rate of graduation from high school will be: _____.

Exit procedures from our specialized language program are:

1. For grades K-2:
 - a. two years at composite level V on the English language development assessment (ELDA); or, in the same year;
 - b. at composite level V on ELDA and at grade-level/benchmark/low-risk on a standardized reading assessment, such as DIBELS Next.
2. For grade 3-8:
 - a. composite level V on ELDA; or, in the same year;
 - b. at composite level 4 IV on ELDA and a proficient on the ELA or English language arts state content assessment.
3. For grades 9-12:
 - a. composite level V on the ELDA; or, in the same year;
 - b. at composite level IV on the ELDA and at proficient on ELA or English state content assessment in the most recent academic year.
