TO: Okmulgee County Election Board

The Board of Education of the Morris School District has approved the following resolution calling for an election to be submitted to the voters of the district.

Date of the Election:

The Board of Education hereby rescinds the election previously scheduled for Tuesday, April 7, 2020 and hereby reschedules this candidate election for June 30, 2020. The polling places shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Voters Eligible to Vote:

To be eligible to vote, a voter must be registered with the county election board at an address within the geographical boundaries of the district.

EMERGENCY LEAVE (REGULATIONS)

For the 2019-2020 school year only, The board of education shall provide not more than ten days each year for emergency leave. These days shall not be chargeable to sick leave and will be noncumulative. The term emergency should be construed to mean a situation or occurrence of a serious nature, developing suddenly and unexpectedly, and demanding immediate attention. Emergency leave will be granted at the discretion of the superintendent or designee.

The board of education may grant leave with pay not to exceed fifteen (15) working days to an employee who is affected by a presidentially declared national disaster in Oklahoma after May 1, 1999, if:

1. The employee suffered a physical injury as a result of the disaster;
2. A relative or household member of the employee suffered a physical injury or died as a result of the disaster; or
3. The domicile of the employee or the domicile of a relative of the employee was damaged or destroyed as a result of the disaster.
