- 8. Motion by Long and seconded by Fogle to approve the school re-opening plan for the 2021-2022 school year. Voting yes were Long, Golay, Fogle and Hampton.

- 10. Motion by Golay and seconded by Hampton to approve the following PO's and Warrants: General Fund PO 1-60 and Warrants 2-29; Building Fund PO 1 and Warrant 1; Child Nutrition PO 1-2 and Warrants 1-2 and General Fund Reserves PO 216 and Warrant 1278.
