### **PROCESS**

You do not need to pre-order. Your child may go to the Mobile Café to get snack or lunch. His/her account that you created and added money to, will be charged. We have a no touch system for meal service payments. Each student has been assigned a bar code that will be kept at the mobile café and will be scanned when he/she accesses the meal service.

### **FREE OR REDUCE MEALS AVAILABLE**

As a public school, Montecito Union School is eligible to participate in the National School Lunch Program. In order for students to participate in this program. Information is attached on how to apply and what process to follow.

### **COST INCREASE**

As you have noticed, the cost of the meals has increase from the prior year. We received the following information from Santa Barbara Unified School District regarding the need for the increase:

Santa Barbara Unified School District has been forced to increase its prices for outside vended programs due to increased costs. The increase in costs are attributable not only to COVID but also to preexisting structural issues within the food services department. SB Unified is attempting to gather donations to cover some of the costs but must also ensure that they aren't losing money on outside vended programs."
