

Zavalla ISD Instructional Options 2020-2021

Traditional On Campus Learning

- Zavalla ISD will follow guidelines and mandates from the State, Texas Education Agency (TEA), and local authorities to ensure a safe learning environment for all students, staff, and faculty.
- Traditional school hours and calendar will be followed
 - Time 7:50 a.m. – 3:20 p.m.
 - August 4th – Teachers Return
 - August 13th – Students Return
- Buses will run their normal schedules - students will be **required** to wear a mask while on the bus to and from school. Students will also have their temperature taken before entering the bus. If a student has a temperature, they will not be allowed on the bus. Please don't send your child to school sick.
- Students enrolled in traditional on campus learning **WILL** be eligible for extracurricular activities, including UIL Academics and Athletics.
- **Transfer students wishing to attend Zavalla ISD will attend school on campus in Zavalla ISD.**
- Zavalla ISD will assign devices for those students needing a Chromebook or Laptop once a Parent Liability form has been signed. Grades 3rd – 12th will be eligible to receive a device.
- All students attending on campus learning will receive daily temperature checks upon arrival to school. If students develop a temperature, parents will be contacted to pick up their child.
- Students in grades 3rd-12th will be required to wear face masks as per the guidelines/governor. They can take their masks off at lunch and during physical activities.
- Social distancing guidelines will be followed.

Online Instruction (*Asynchronous Instructional Model*)

- Instruction will be delivered online via Google Classroom.
- Zavalla ISD will assign devices for those students needing a Chromebook or Laptop once a Parent Liability form has been signed. Grades 3rd – 12th will be eligible to receive a device.
- Attendance will be taken **DAILY**. Students will login each class period in order to receive attendance credit.
- Students will be required to turn in assignments at the designated time by each teacher (the grading policy will be the same for both on campus and online instruction).
- Students enrolled in online instruction **WILL NOT** be eligible for extracurricular activities, including UIL Academics and Athletics.

- Standards for online learning are more detailed and rigorous compared to our extended school closure last spring. Students will be responsible for daily completion of lessons, with a minimum of four hours per day to meet TEA academic requirements.
- All grading, progress reports, report cards, and attendance requirements will follow the same guidelines as traditional on campus learning.
