

Dyslexia Program

During the 2018-2019 school year, Carlisle Public School District used the following evidenced-based IMSE (Institute for Multi-Sensory Education) using Orton-Gillingham strategies, Phonics First (Brainspring), Structures (Brainspring) and Project Read Linguistics dyslexia intervention programs in small group interventions to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention

During the 2018-2019 school year, **38** students attending Carlisle Public School District **received** dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia

During the 2018-2019 school year, **12** students attending Carlisle Public School District were **identified** as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

Since 2015, **45** students have been identified as exhibiting characteristics of dyslexia in the Carlisle School District.
