

Pre-K Enrollment FAQ's

1. **How many Pre-K students can enroll?** We have positions for 60 three- and four-year olds.
2. **How is my child's Pre-K placement chosen?** Pre-K program is offered in our school. Students are placed on a first come first serve basis. Parents will be notified by letter or phone regarding their child's placement.
3. **Do all Pre-K students attend free of charge?** No. A state issued income guideline is used to determine a child's placement. If your child qualifies for free placement, then no payment is required. Tuition students may also attend. Tuition amount is \$250/month and is due on the 15th of the following months: August, September, October, November, December, January, February, March, April and May.
4. **Does Carlisle School District provide transportation?** No, Carlisle Public Schools do NOT transport Preschool age students to or from school.
5. **What are the hours of operation?** Pre-K hours are 7:50am-2:50pm. Students cannot be dropped off prior to 7:50am and must be picked up no later than 2:50pm.
6. **When will I know which class my child will attend?** Students will be placed in a classroom once a registration is verified. Parent's will be notified of an appointment time to bring all required verification documents, which will occur on April 7, 2020. On this day, April 7, 2020, ARcare will be onsite with their mobile unit providing Pre-K/Kindergarten physicals as well as immunizations for any child that needs these. Those who have completed online registration, an appointment for document verification will be scheduled and parents will be notified.
7. **How will I know who my child's teacher will be?** You will receive a letter in the mail stating your child's teacher by the end of May. Pre-K open house is August 11th and the first day of school is August 13th.

8. **May I request a teacher?** Unfortunately, we are unable to honor all requests.

9. **Does Carlisle School District provide afterschool care for Pre-K?** No.

10. **What happens once all 60 slots are filled?** Students are placed on a waiting list. You will be contacted as a slot becomes available.

11. **Why is it important to complete online registration and attend appointments?** A student will not be registered until the online registration and all document verification is complete.

Bring the following to your registration appointment:

- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Social Security Card
- Proof of income for ALL adults in the home equal to 1 month of pay. Copy of "adjusted gross income" from 2019 tax return. No Income Statement for anyone not working (we have available at Carlisle Pre-K)
- Current shot record- the final series of shots cannot be given until after your child's 4th birthday*
- Physical (may be either the 3 or 4-year-old well child check)
