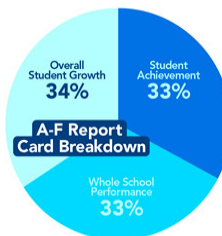

2011 Performance: 33% of the overall grade is based on the Oklahoma School Testing Program assessments in grades three (3) through twelve (12). Overall Student Growth: 3.4% of the grade is based on annual student learning gains as measured by Oklahoma's annual standardized assessments in reading and mathematics in grades three (3) through eight (8), and Algebra I and English II end-of-instruction tests.

Bottom Quartile Student Growth: 0% is based on the growth of the bottom 25 percent of students as measured by Oklahoma's annual standardized assessments in reading and mathematics in grades three(3) through eight(8), and Algebra I and English II end-of-instruction tests for the lowest 25 percent of students in the school.

Whole School Performance: 33% of the final grade is based on whole school improvement, based on a variety of factors including attendance, dropout rate and parent & community engagement.

Reading or math percent tested less than 95%. School letter grade dropped one letter grade.

Reading or math percent tested less than 90%. School letter grade automatic F.
