#### Call to Order

Todd Guice welcomed Clint Miller to the committee.

VI. Approve Minutes of August 18, 2020

Mickey Merritt made the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Steven Hemphill, after an offer for public discussion, the motion carried.

### VII. Business:

 Financial Report for September 30, 2020 Regina Mekus, Business Director

As of the period ending June 30, 2020 current balance is \$30,676,000, which is 110% of what we expected. MFP is higher than it should be due to projected student count from the state which is higher than our projected student count. Sales tax collections are up 7% overall parish wide.

M & O is up 108% of projected fund balance. 1995 sales tax fund balance is \$7,000,000. Child Nutrition current ending fund balance is \$6,000,000 also 108% fund balance but should level out over the rest of the year.

Debt Service funds - market is very good to refinance bonds - (See attached documents for details)

2. Investment Report

Regina Mekus, Business Director

Snapshot of Cash Equivalents and Investment Schedule – we are up about \$2,000,000 from last year. LAMP .1% daily rate – interest rates are very low, so we are watching investments very closely. (See attached documents)

 Revision of Fixed Asset Procedure Manual Regina Mekus, Business Director

4. Discussion of Staffing for the Remainder of 2020 – 2021 School Year Todd Guice and Don Coker

A decline of 550 student enrollments from last year means we are over staffed. Reduction of MFP in 2021 will mean a \$3 to \$4.5 million drop in funds. We are looking at 28 certified openings at the end of the calendar year; some will be filled with long term substitutes. We will have to continue to be proactive in staffing to keep from having a RIF or a hire freeze.

### VIII: Other Items

Dr. Coker discussed the renewal of the 10 year M & O Sales tax coming up in April of 2021, maybe look at making it a perpetual tax. The Board will discuss this more in the December meeting.

# Statement of Probable Cost Riser Elementary School 100 Price Drive West Monroe, LA

# A. Riser Elementary School: Approximately 106,000 sq. ft. - Modified Bit Roof System

- We took a total of 6 core cuts on this roof and all were found to be dry. We found a metal deck with light weight concrete, iso, and perlite with one layer of modified. Core depths ranged from 5 inches thick at the low ends to 10 inches thick on the ridges.
- Installation: PVC System: Install a 60 mil PVC roll goods over existing modified bitumen roof system.
- Warranty: The single ply PVC system is a <u>20-year warranty</u> that included labor and material.
- 4. Re-install existing downspouts, gutters, splashpads, and new metal flashings.

Total Cost: \$750,000.00 - \$775,000.00

The Statement of Probable Cost is based upon industry standards at sq. ft. pricing. The prices vary due to catastrophe, material cost, including supply and demand.


