This pre-k skill goal sheet that is a fun and very visual way for the kids to see what skills they have mastered. When a skill has been mastered, the child can put a sticker in the box. If you use the black and white version another idea is to have the students color the square or picture once they meet a goal. Excellent motivation to meet learning goals

These can be kept in data folders in your classroom or I have seen some teachers post them on wall. This form of communication allows students to see all the have learned as well as informing parents to see what their child has mastered and where they may need extra support and help.


I have also added data notebooks that can be copied for students and used as assessment data for students as they meet the standards. These are great to keep for student teacher conferences to show parents what each standard looks like when assessed. I have included different version that you can use to meet your needs.

I usually circle the items that students know. I have multiple color pens available and use a different color pen each time I assess students and date. This allows me to see over time what has been mastered and when. I included the sight word list that we use but feel free to swap it out for the sight words that you use.


For rhyming and segmenting, I have included quick check/ assessments for students at multiple levels so you can determine what mastery might look like in your classroom.

For letter names, letter sounds and counting to a certain number, each time I assess, I circle what they know. I use a different pen each time I assess and date it as more documentation of their learning.






