Instructions to Set Up Access to & Check Student Grades

If you have a Student Progress Center account from last year, you DO NOT need to set up a NEW ACCOUNT.

- Go to <u>www.opsb.net</u>
- Click on Campus, Click on LAKESHORE ELEMENTARY.

- Click CONTINUE.
- Create your personal Login and Password. You will be the only person with access to this information. THE SCHOOL DOES NOT HAVE ACCESS TO YOUR LOGIN INFORMATION.
- Carefully answer the two security questions.
- Click COMPLETE.

Instructions to LINK ADDITONAL STUDENTS to Your STUDENT PROGRESS CENTER

- 1. Log into Student Progress Center.
- 2. Click LINK STUDENTS under Make Selection (top right-hand corner).
- Enter Last Name of STUDENT.
- Enter First Name of STUDENT.
- Enter the STUDENT'S social security number.
- Enter the STUDENT'S BIRTHDATE.
- Click SUBMIT.
- Continue until all students/siblings have been linked.

Using a Cell Phone

- Go to your phone's app store.
- Download the OUACHITA PARISH SCHOOLS app.
