Bonus Point Information

Students will have the opportunity to earn 50 bonus points in each subject Reading, Phonics, and Math. . I will use a rubric to score them on the work. Half of the bonus points are earned through completion of the assignments over the 4 week period. The other half of the bonus points is earned through quality or work (how they do on the lessons). The points will be averaged into the 3rd nine weeks averages (ones you just got report cards on). In kindergarten, the 1st nine weeks doesn't count towards end of year averages, so we will then average only the 2nd and 3rd nine weeks averages together to get the end of year grades. *This bonus work is not mandatory and is optional for all students.

**Bonus work starts next week Monday, April 20th and will last for 4 weeks through May 15th.

Bonus work will come from the online website www.login.i-ready.com. You can use a desktop/laptop computer or an ipad(download the iReady app). The website is not compatible with phones. Students will complete 3 reading lessons and 2 math lessons each week on the iReady website. This will still be review type material. For most students a learning path was created in math based on the diagnostic test they took at school. You will just need to complete at least 2 lessons of those lessons. If there is no learning path, that means your child did not take a diagnostic test at school and will just complete the assigned lessons in each subject that week. Lessons in math will go towards bonus points in math. Lessons in reading will go towards bonus points in reading and phonics.
