The Lavaca School District uses National School Lunch State Categorical Funds to provide for students scoring below proficiency in order to improve instruction and increase academic achievement for those students. Lavaca School District employs a .55 FTE curriculum specialist and a .47 school Director of Safety and Security (district employee) to assist the district with monitoring absentees and connect both homeless students and families/students in need to resources available to them. \$100 in funds will be used to support student security/safety needs. The curriculum specialist will research and lead in supplementing the implementation of programs and professional development activities that will align curriculum and instruction and have a positive impact on student achievement. Materials and supplies will be purchased to support curriculum and instruction. Professional development with a curriculum focus such as AACIA or similar conferences will be funded (\$800). Training and materials to support the dyslexia intervention program will be purchased (\$1175).

Lavaca Elementary School: .625 FTE dyslexia interventionist, .05 FTE to facilitate effective electronic parent/family and community involvement and communication, .25 FTE interventionist.

Lavaca Middle School: .375 FTE dyslexia interventionist, .50 FTE special education aide, .05 FTE to facilitate effective electronic parent/family and community involvement and communication, and a .60 FTE special education aide.

Lavaca High School: .625 FTE aide, 1.0 special education aide, .10 FTE dyslexia interventionist, and .05 FTE to facilitate effective electronic parent/family and community involvement and communication, .50 FTE special education aide. Funds will also be used in each school to support curricular resources such as interim assessments through NWEA (MAP), AETN's Discovery Streaming, Classworks, and Renaissance Learning in order to enrich student learning experiences. Tech will also be purchased using NSL funds. \$10000 will be transferred to Professional Development to supplement professional development. \$2500 will be transferred from NSL to AE to support the AE program.
