2020 FOOTBALL TICKETING PLAN

According to UIL rules, schools may allow spectators to attend games, contests or events within a **maximum 50% capacity limitation**, provided that appropriate spacing between spectators is maintained according to the protocol and according to the following:

- Signs will be posted with messaging stating any individual who is confirmed to have, suspected of having, are experiencing symptoms of, or have been in close contact with an individual who has been confirmed to have COVID-19 should not enter the facility.
- Spectators, audiences, fans and media are required to wear face coverings as described in **Executive Order GA-29**.
- Groups should maintain at least six feet of distance from other groups at all times, including the process of admission and seating. A group is defined as no more than 10 people including the members of the household and those persons who traveled together to the facility.
- Seating will not be allowed in consecutive rows. Rows will be blocked off to maintain a minimum six feet of distance between groups. There will be areas for lawn chairs. These will be limited to groups of 10.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at the entrance and inside the facility.
- Seating, hand rails, and other common surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected prior to each game.

In order to ensure that Cranfills Gap ISD is in compliance with the maximum 50% capacity limitation, all tickets for both Junior High and High School Varsity football games will be **PRESALE ONLY**. We will not be taking money at the gate. One hundred eighty (180) tickets will be sold.

Tickets will be sold as follows:

Monday & Tuesday All participants and staff (football and cheer) may purchase up to four (4) tickets for that week's game- these will be available at the office.

Wednesday & Thursday General public may purchase tickets. Please call the office to reserve your ticket. You will come to the front of the school, call the office at 254-263-3388 and we will bring your tickets out to you.

The number of available tickets or the process of entrance to a game, will be adjusted for away games in accordance with maximum capacities of the home team's stadium. We will post on our website and Facebook each Monday of an away game.

No passes or money will be accepted at the gate for home games. All pass holders will need to pick up their tickets each week if they plan to go to the game.

CGISD employees will be allotted up to two complimentary tickets (home games only). These will need to be picked up from office Monday-Tuesday.

Concession Stands and Food Service

- Staff and volunteers involved in food service are required to wear face coverings as described in **Executive Order GA-29**.
- We will be offering a limited menu this season to help avoid the spread of germs.
- CGISD will only provide condiments or flatware upon request, and in single use, individually wrapped items.
- Before each game, CGISD will follow the screening protocols described above to screen staff and volunteers who will be involved in food service

prior to events. These individuals should also self-screen as described in screening protocols.

Please help us to be able to continue to enjoy student activities by following the rules and abiding by the guidance listed above. Even though schools are required to screen spectators, it is each person's responsibility to self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms before arriving at a UIL activity.
