Although you sometimes hear about this test when it comes to the military, it is not a military test. The military will NOT receive your information, and no members of the military will be recruiting at any point before, during, or after this test. (However, those interested in pursuing military careers can use these scores later on when they enlist.) This test has 8 sections: Science, Math Knowledge, Word Knowledge, Arithmetic, Paragraph Comprehension, Electronics, Auto & Shop, and Mechanical. Students will also participate in an interest inventory and will learn how to search for careers that combine their interests and academic strengths.
