Baumstarck was the 2nd overall winner and high individual in placings. The team of Baumstarck, senior, Olivia Shaffer, senior Odalys Osorio-Alcala, sophomore Cayden Robertson, and sophomore Waylon Lissman finished 3rd overall, 1st high team in placings, 4th place in reasons, and 3rd place on the rail at the 7220 Invitational Wool Judging contest held in Laramie on Tuesday, January 11th.

Baumstarck continued her winning trend at the National Western Stock Show. She was the high individual overall, the high individual in placings, 2nd high on the rail, and 2nd high in questions. Shaffer was the 3rd high individual overall, the 3rd high individual in placings, the high individual in grading, and the 3rd high individual in questions.
