Dear Parents and Students and Staff,

Roff Public School has learned that one staff member and two elementary students tested positive for COVID-19. Due to school policy and health department regulations, the individuals who tested positive are staying at home until it is safe to return to school. Due to federal health privacy laws, information regarding the individuals' identities cannot be released. Please respect the privacy of these individuals during this time.

Upon learning the news, Roff School contacted the Pontotoc County Health Department for their guidance. **Representatives of Roff School have made contact with any staff members and the parents of any students that may have come in close contact with the individuals who tested positive.** Those staff members and students who have come in close contact will be required to stay at home based upon school guidelines for COVID-19 and health department regulations.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends contacting your doctor if you believe you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop a fever, loss of the sense of taste or smell and other symptoms, such as coughing or difficulty breathing.
