As you have heard, this year's graduation is June 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. at the stadium. As you are aware, until further notice we are still having to plan responsibly and follow recommended guidelines from governmental officials relating to the development of COVID-19. This correspondence is to give you directives moving forward. Please note the deadlines, as it is somewhat challenging making plans for the upcoming events.

- (1.) ALL dues must be paid in full to participate in graduation no later than May 20<sup>th</sup>. Please contact the school to make arrangements to tend to your financial obligation(s).
- (2.) Virtual Honors Program will be May 22<sup>nd</sup>. Please go on YouTube to view.
- (3.) Caps and gowns may be picked up on Friday, June 12<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- (4.) Graduation practice is June 17<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. followed by your luncheon.
- (5.) Graduation is June 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. with social distancing guidelines strictly adhered. You will be given eight (8) tickets to give to your guests. However, in the event that you are unable to participate on this date, you have two other options to have graduation memories:
  - Option 1: Mail my diploma directly to me and forfeit a ceremony.
  - Option 2: Private, individualized ceremony. You may invite up to as many guests to be present for receiving of your diploma. However, social distancing guidelines will apply. All private ceremonies will be held in the auditorium on Saturday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until completed. Each ceremony will last approximately 15 minutes.
