**HB 5 COMMUNITY AND STUDENT ENGAGEMENT PERFORMANCE RATINGS**  
**2014**

One of the major changes made to the accountability portion of House Bill 5 was the creation of the Community and Student Engagement Accountability Rating, which requires each district to evaluate the district's performance and the performance of each campus within the district on community and student engagement and in policy compliance. Each district will now be required to assign itself and each of its campuses a rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable or unacceptable for both overall performance and for each of the 9 evaluation factors.

The categories included in the evaluation and rating consisted of: Fine Arts, Wellness & Physical Education, Community & Parent Involvement, 21st Century Workforce Development Program, 2nd Language Acquisition, Digital Language Acquisition Program, Dropout Prevention Strategies, Educational Programs for GT Students, and Compliance with Statutory Reporting & Policy Requirements
