

Amos Pavlik Memorial Scholarship

(Offered by the Fayette County Czech Heritage Society)

The Fayette County Czech Heritage Society is offering the 2022 Amos Pavlik Memorial Scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 to a graduating Fayette County high school senior who exemplifies academic achievement, outstanding merit, and the spirit of involvement, volunteerism and leadership as evidenced through extracurricular activities. Applicants must be able to show that they have Czech ancestry and express in an essay what their Czech heritage means to them. Preference will be given to applicants who are related to a member of the local CHS chapter. The chosen recipient will be notified by the first week of April 2022 and will be recognized at a school awards ceremony and/or a meeting of the Fayette County Czech Heritage Society at a date to be announced. The money will be awarded upon proof of acceptance in a program of studies at a university, college or technical school.

Eligibility requirements:

- Applicant must have Czech ancestry.
- Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Fayette County High School for the current school year and will be evaluated based on academics, extracurricular activities, leadership and involvement in school and community.
- Applicant will be evaluated based on a 400-500 word, typed, double-spaced essay defining what your Czech heritage means to you, how it has influenced you, your current and past Czech cultural involvement, how you plan to preserve and promote your Czech heritage in the future, and why you think you should be selected for this scholarship.
- Applicant must include two letters of recommendation. One should be from a high school teacher attesting to the student's academic promise. The other from an adult attesting to the student's interest in Czech culture.

Information to include with application:

- 1) Completed and signed application
- 2) Official high school transcript
- 3) On a separate sheet of paper please attach a 2x3 headshot photo with your name under the photo; also explain your biological Czech ancestry; i.e., parent, grandparent, etc. (give names)
- 4) Essay of 400-500 words, typed, double spaced
- 5) Two letters of recommendation
