I find that the rest of my classmates have left Fayetteville. But since I was going to Houston, I will be able to see them.


Near Industry I passed the big hog farm that belongs to the former Jo Ann Grebe and her husband. I hear that they are getting rich with the hog prices the way they are.

Upon entering Houston, I find that my former classmate, Ruth Dean Fritsch, is married to the manager of some big machine shop and is doing fine.


Mary Jane Muesse has also settled in Houston. She and her husband and daughter live happily in one of the new residential districts near the steel mill where her husband is foreman.




I. Ben L. Halamicek, think that I have made good use of the day; and when I return to the air base, where I test jet planes, I will have many pleasant memories of the past and present.



The Fayetteville Chapter of Future Farmers of America consisting of twenty-eight members began the year with Wayne Lee Wied as president of the chapter.


The Lions Basketball Team opened the season with only one regular returning from last year's team. So prospects for an excellent season weren't too good.

The co-captains are Ben L. Halamicek and George Norwood.






