The Fayetteville Lions placed Co-Champs in District 68-B this 1962 season. The Lions hold a seasonal record of 15 victories and 8 losses.

The Lions entered three tournaments during this season. At the Waelder tournament we won a good sportsmanship trophy. We entered the Smithville tournament and placed third. Schley was placed on the all-tournament team for his efforts.

Our district games proved very good with a 7 to 1 seasonal record, tied for first place with Carmine. In the play-off game, Carmine defeated us by a mere score of 48 to 47.

The Lions were honored by District 68-B when Victor Havran was selected as one of the all-district players and the following four team mates were given honorable mention: Schley, Rohde, Aschenbeck, and Treybig.

The individual scoring honors for the season went to Schley 285, Havran 263, Aschenbeck 245, Treybig 207, Rohde 153, Mascheck 71, Heinsohn 60, and Kubena 38.

The average points made per game was a 47.5 record.
