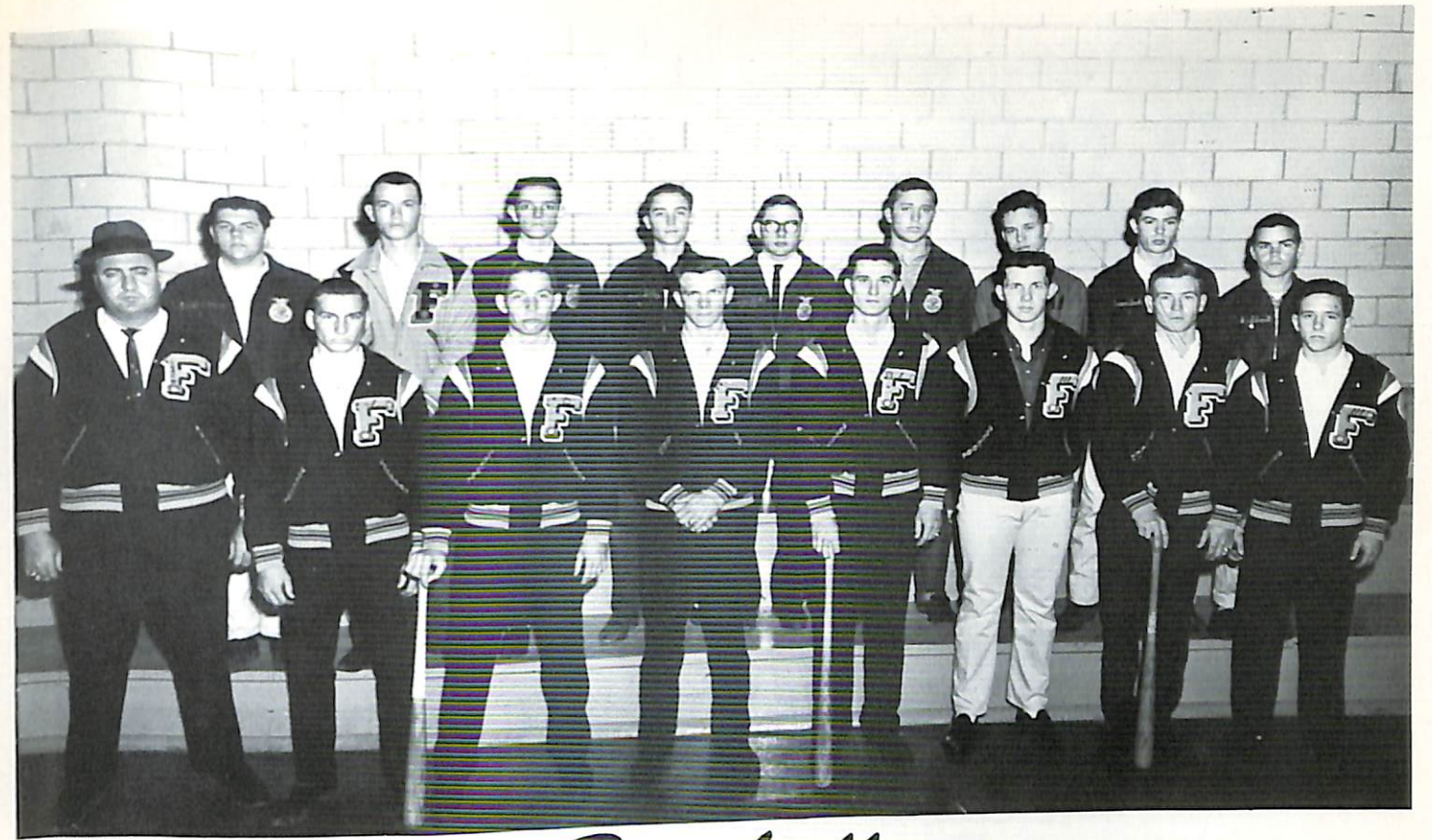


Boys Basketball
