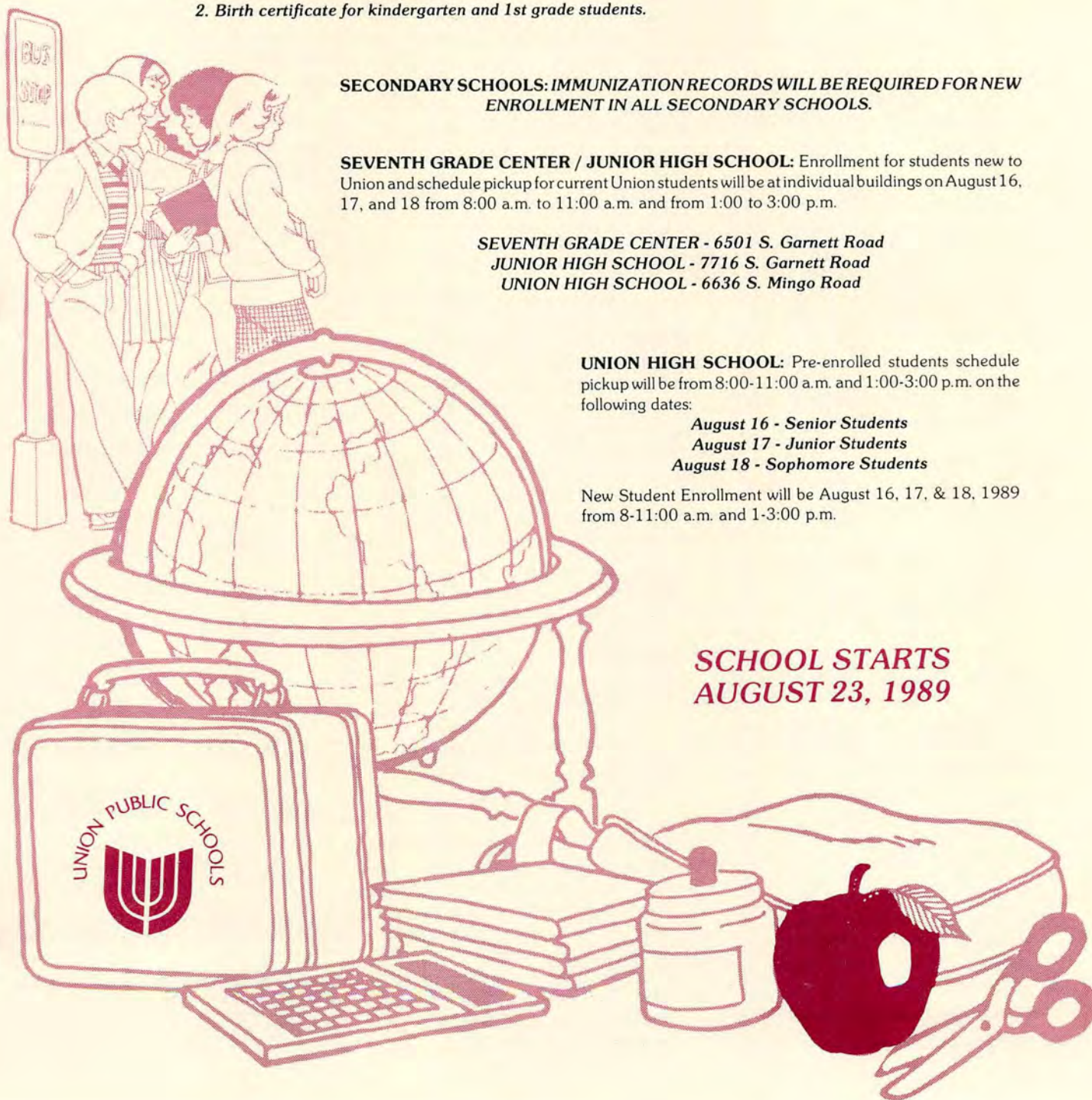

ANNOUNCING UNION'S FIRST NIGHT SCHOOL

Union will begin its first night school in September. This school will be for our high school students and students from surrounding schools. Having night school classes will permit students in grades nine through twelve more flexibility to improve their day schedules. Also, it will give present high school students and even older students an opportunity to make up any course to complete their graduation requirements in order to receive their high school diplomas.

Night school classes will meet on Monday and Wednesday evenings from 5-7 p.m. and 7-9 p.m. For example, a student may take an English class from 5-7 p.m. and a Math class from 7-9 p.m., or any other combination of classes chosen from the curriculum. A student could choose to take

one class per semester, equaling ½ credit, or he could choose to take two classes per semester, equaling one credit. As in summer school, students will pay a \$60.00 tuition fee for each class taken. The following curriculum will be offered:

MATH - General Math, Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry.

SCIENCE - General Science, Physical Science, Biology.

ENGLISH - English 9, 10, 11, & 12.

SOCIAL STUDIES - Oklahoma History, U.S. History (to 1865), U.S. History (reconstruction to present), World History.

ENRICHMENT - Aerobics/P.E., Spanish I, French I.

Enrollment dates have been set for September 11 through 15, and September 18 through 20, from 3:00-4:30 p.m. The place of enrollment will be at the new 7th Grade Center, located at 6501 S. Garnett. For more information, you may call Dolan Powell at 250-9541 beginning August 22.

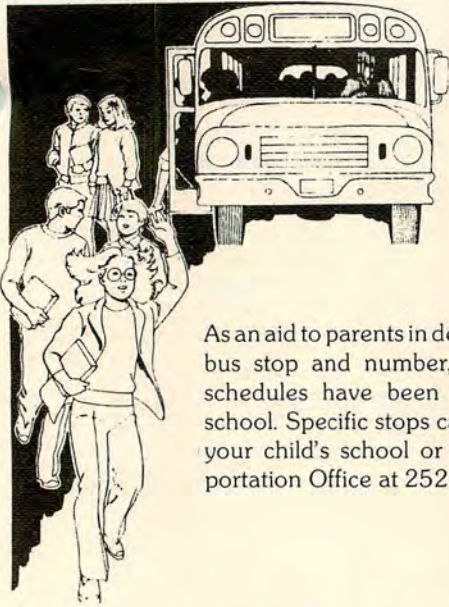
